

RESOLUTION 1830

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AND STAFF TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR WWRP-TRAILS GRANT FUNDS FOR TANNER TRAIL ACQUISITION AND DEVELOPMENT

WHEREAS, the City desires to make improvements to the Tanner Trail to extend the trail from the roundabout located at Cedar Falls Way to the existing City Public Works building, including the portion that will be adjacent to the new City Hall (“Project”); and

WHEREAS, these improvements are included within the Parks Element of the City’s Comprehensive Plan and the City’s Parks Capital Improvements Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to apply for the State Recreation and Conservation Office grant, Washington Wildlife and Recreation Program (“WWRP”) – trails category;

WHEREAS, in order to meet the grant application criteria, the City is willing to provide up to \$110,000 for the match for the grant; and

WHEREAS, the Si View Metropolitan Parks District is also pledging to commit funds to the Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Authorizing City Staff to Submit WWRP Grant Application and Matching Funds. The City Council authorizes City Staff to submit a grant application requesting WWRP-Trail grant funds for Tanner Trail and authorizing matching funds of up to \$110,000.

Section 2. Authorizing the Mayor to Sign the Grant Application and the Authorization Resolution. The City Council authorizes the Mayor to execute the final grant application and all necessary materials to submit the application, including the authorization resolution attached hereto as Attachment A, allowing the Mayor to sign an agreement should the City receive the applied for grant funds.
