

RESOLUTION 1832

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, ACCEPTING THE BENDIGO BOULEVARD AT PARK STREET NORTHBOUND RIGHT TURN LANE PROJECT AS COMPLETE AND AUTHORIZING THE RELEASE OF RETAINAGE

WHEREAS, the City committed funds in the 2016 and 2017 budget to provide funding for the Bendigo Blvd. at Park Street Northbound Right Turn Lane Project; and

WHEREAS, upon completion of design, bids were received on September 7, 2016, with eight (8) bids having been received; and

WHEREAS, the resulting lowest responsive and responsible bidder out of eight (8) bids received was from Sierra Pacific Construction, LLC in the amount of \$241,606.00; and

WHEREAS, Sierra Pacific Construction, LLC began work on the project on October 27, 2016; and

WHEREAS, there were four City Council approved change orders in the amount of \$74,051.00 increasing the contract amount to \$315,657.00; and

WHEREAS, the Bendigo Blvd at Park Street Northbound Right Turn Lane Project was declared Physically Complete on April 25, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the final construction cost of the project was \$315,656.40; and

WHEREAS, the City must accept the project prior to submitting for releases from the State Department of Revenue, Department of Labor and Industries, and the Employment Security Department for the retainage of the contractors;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND,
WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The City of North Bend accepts the Sierra Pacific Construction, LLC work on the Bendigo Blvd. at Park Street Northbound Right Turn Lane Project.

Section 2. The City of North Bend authorizes the release of the retainage on the contract upon receipt of the appropriate clearances from the state.
