

RESOLUTION 1836

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, AWARDED CONTRACT TO WCCL SYSTEMS, LLC FOR THE 2018 SANITARY SEWER MANHOLE REPAIR PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City owns and operates a Publicly Owned Treatment Works (POTW), including a Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) and sewage collection system; and

WHEREAS, portions of the sewage collection system are aging and beginning to leak, contributing to excessive inflow and infiltration (I&I); and

WHEREAS, this I&I uses capacity at the WWTP that could otherwise be used to treat sewage; and

WHEREAS, the City has a vested interest in reducing I&I to reduce impacts to the WWTP; and

WHEREAS, City staff have identified the nine sanitary sewer manholes with the worst I&I problems; and

WHEREAS, City staff solicited repair quotes from three (3) contractors listed on the Municipal Research and Services Center (MRSC) Small Works Roster; and

WHEREAS, the lowest responsive and responsible quote was received from WCCL Systems, LLC of Tacoma, WA in the amount of \$8,385.30, including taxes;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The construction contract for the 2018 Sanitary Sewer Manhole Repair Project, on a form to be approved by the City Attorney, is awarded to WCCL Systems, LLC, in the amount of \$8,358.30, including all applicable taxes.
