

RESOLUTION 1853

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, ACCEPTING THE WWTP WASHROOM MOLD REMOVAL PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING THE RELEASE OF RETAINAGE

WHEREAS, the City owns and operates a Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP); and

WHEREAS, in April 2018 City staff discovered the presence of black mold in the washroom of the WWTP control building; and

WHEREAS, staff solicited bids from three contractors registered on the MRSC Small Works Roster to remediate the problem; and

WHEREAS, ServPro of Issaquah/North Bend submitted the lowest quote in the amount of \$2,004.34, including all taxes; and

WHEREAS, a contract between the City and ServPro of Issaquah/North Bend was executed on May 4, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the work was satisfactorily completed on May 4, 2018 at a total cost of \$2,004.34; and

WHEREAS, the City must accept the projects prior to submitting for releases from the State Department of Revenue, Department of Labor and Industries, and the Employment Security Department for the retainage of the contractors;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City of North Bend accepts the ServPro of Issaquah/North Bend work on the WWTP Washroom Mold Removal project.

Section 2. The City of North Bend authorizes the release of the retainage on the contract upon receipt of the appropriate clearances from the appropriate agencies of the State of Washington.
