

RESOLUTION 1854

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, ACCEPTING THE SW 10TH STREET CULVERT MAINTENANCE PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING THE RELEASE OF RETAINAGE

WHEREAS, In April 2018, the City's Public Works Department became aware of an excess build-up of streambed material within the 4-foot bottomless arch culvert on SW 10th Street adjacent to the 710 Pump Station in the Forster Woods neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, quotes were solicited from three contractors from the MRSC Small Works Roster, with one (1) bid having been received; and

WHEREAS, the resulting lowest responsive and responsible bidder was Fury Site Works, Inc. in the amount of \$17,894.45; and

WHEREAS, Fury Site Works Inc., began work on the project on September 20, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the SW 10th Street Culvert Maintenance Project was declared Physically Complete on September 28, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the final construction cost of the project was \$17,467.56; and

WHEREAS, the City must accept the projects prior to submitting for releases from the State Department of Revenue, Department of Labor and Industries, and the Employment Security Department for the retainage of the contractors;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City of North Bend accepts the Fury Site Works, Inc. work on the SW 10th Street Culvert Maintenance Project.

Section 2. The City of North Bend authorizes the release of the retainage on the contract upon receipt of the appropriate clearances from the state.
