

RESOLUTION 1858

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, ACCEPTING THE NE 12th STREET IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT AS COMPLETE AND AUTHORIZING THE RELEASE OF RETAINAGE

WHEREAS, the NE 12th Street Improvements Project moved up the priority list of the 6-year Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) during the past several years as large sections of failing asphalt, failing culverts, poor drainage, and unsafe driving conditions made this a priority project for the City; and

WHEREAS, engineering design for this work was completed by BlueLine in April of this year after a few years of back and forth with staff on the ultimate configuration of the roadway; and

WHEREAS, a bid opening was held on June 27, 2018 and seven (7) bids were received; and

WHEREAS, the resulting lowest responsive and responsible bidder was Fury Site Works, Inc. in the amount of \$1,458,520.74; and

WHEREAS, Fury Site Works Inc., began work on the project on August 8, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the NE 12th Street Improvements Project was declared Physically Complete on October 31, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the final construction cost of the project was \$1,349,874.75; and

WHEREAS, the City must accept the project prior to submitting for releases from the State Department of Revenue, Department of Labor and Industries, and the Employment Security Department for the retainage of the contractors;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND,
WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The City of North Bend accepts Fury Site Works, Inc. work on the NE 12th Street Improvements Project.

Section 2. The City of North Bend authorizes the release of the retainage on the contract upon receipt of the appropriate clearances from the state.
