

# RESOLUTION 1864

## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, ACCEPTING THE 2018 SANITARY SEWER MANHOLE REPAIRS PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING THE RELEASE OF RETAINAGE

**WHEREAS**, the City owns and operates a wastewater treatment plant (WWTP) and sanitary sewer collection and conveyance system; and

**WHEREAS**, Staff had identified several leaky manholes throughout the sewer system; and

**WHEREAS**, these leaks contribute to inflow and infiltration (I&I) that allows groundwater and stormwater into the system, and ultimately into the WWTP; and

**WHEREAS**, treating this extra flow increases the cost of treating sewage as well as increasing the potential for overwhelming the WWTP; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the City's best interests to reduce I&I, where possible; and

**WHEREAS**, the City requested bids from three (3) companies listed on the MRSC Small Works Roster that specialize in sewer manhole repair and rehabilitation; and

**WHEREAS**, the lowest responsive and responsible quote was submitted by WCCL Systems, LLC in the amount of \$8,385.30, including taxes; and

**WHEREAS**, the work was satisfactorily completed on July 9, 2018 at a total cost of \$8,385.30, including taxes; and

**WHEREAS**, the City must accept the projects prior to submitting for releases from the State Department of Revenue, Department of Labor and Industries, and the Employment Security Department for the retainage of the contractors;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The City of North Bend accepts the WCCL Systems, LLC work on the 2018 Sanitary Sewer Manhole Repairs Project.

**Section 2.** The City of North Bend authorizes the release of the retainage on the contract upon receipt of the appropriate clearances from the appropriate agencies of the State of Washington.
