

RESOLUTION 1878

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, ACCEPTING CONSTRUCTION BIDS AND AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT HIGH PRIORITY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City entered into a professional services contract with Gray & Osborne, Inc. to design the Wastewater Treatment Plant High Priority Improvements Project; and

WHEREAS, upon completion of design, the City published an advertisement for construction bids on January 23, 2019 and January 30, 2019 in the Seattle Daily Journal of Commerce. The City also published an advertisement for construction bids on January 25, 2019 and February 1, 2019 in the Snoqualmie Valley Record; and

WHEREAS, the City received three (3) bids and on March 7, 2019, the City opened the received bids at North Bend City Hall and read them aloud at the prescribed time; and

WHEREAS, the resulting lowest responsive and responsible bidder out of three (3) bids the City received was that of McClure and Sons, Inc. in the amount of \$8,938,403.10, including all additive items and applicable taxes;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City accepts the construction bids for the Wastewater Treatment Plant High Priority Improvements Project.

Section 2. The City awards the construction contract for the Wastewater Treatment Plant High Priority Improvements Project, on a form to be approved by the City Attorney, to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, McClure and Sons, Inc., in the amount of \$8,938,403.10, including all additive items and applicable taxes.
