

ORDINANCE 1695

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, UPDATING NORTH BEND MUNICIPAL CODE REFERENCES RELATING TO THE NEW CITY HALL, AMENDING NORTH BEND MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTERS 2.04.11 AND 2.04.12 COUNCIL; AND CHAPTER 2.08.020 CITY CLERK; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of North Bend (“City”) has constructed a new City Hall building located at 920 SE Cedar Falls Way; and

WHEREAS, the current North Bend Municipal Code (“NBMC”) makes reference to City Council and Planning Commission meetings to be held at the Mt. Si Senior Center (411 Main Avenue South) and/or the old City Hall (211 Main Avenue North); and

WHEREAS, these meetings will now take place within the new City Hall building located at 920 SE Cedar Falls Way; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend the NBMC to make reference to the new City Hall location and avoid confusion as to the location of the aforementioned meetings;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. NBMC Section 2.04.11 (Regular council Meeting – Time and Place)

Amended: North Bend Municipal Code Section 2.04.11 (Regular council Meeting – Time and Place) is hereby amended to read as follows:

The city council shall hold regular meetings commencing at 7:00 p.m. on the first and third Tuesdays of each month at North Bend City Hall, 920 SE Cedar Falls Way, ~~the Mt. Si Senior Center, 411 Main Avenue South~~, North Bend, or such other times and locations as determined by the council and in accordance with state law.

Section 2. NBMC Section 2.04.12 (Regular council workstudy – Time, place and conditions)

Amended: North Bend Municipal Code Section 2.04.12 (Regular council workstudy – Time, place and conditions) is hereby amended to read as follows:

The city council shall hold a workstudy on the fourth Tuesday of each month, with a set agenda of discussion, commencing at 7:00 p.m. at North Bend City Hall, 920 SE

~~Cedar Falls Way 211 Main Avenue North~~, North Bend, or such other times and locations as determined by the council and in accordance with state law. Workstudy meetings shall be presided over by the mayor pro tem, or by the mayor in the absence of the mayor pro tem. No ordinance or resolution shall be passed, contract let or entered into, or bill for the payment of money approved at a council workstudy.

Section 3. NBMC Section 2.08.020 (Damage claims agent) Amended: North Bend Municipal Code Section 2.08.020 (Damage claims agent) is hereby amended to read as follows:

The city clerk is hereby appointed to be the city agent responsible to receive claims for damages made under RCW Title 4. Other than vacation, sick leave, and other temporary absences, the city clerk shall be available to receive claims for damages during normal City Hall business hours at North Bend City Hall, 920 SE Cedar Falls Way, 211 Main Avenue North, North Bend, Washington, 98045.

Section 4. Severability: Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstance, be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid for any reason, or should any portion of this ordinance be pre-empted by state or federal law or regulation, such decision or pre-emption shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance or its application to other persons or circumstances.

Section 5. Effective Date: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after the date of signing.
