

# RESOLUTION 1899

## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING A FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITIES OF ISSAQUAH AND SNOQUALMIE FOR 911 POLICE DISPATCH SERVICES AND POLICE DISPATCH AND RECORDS MANAGEMENT SERVICE

**WHEREAS**, on March 8, 2014, the City of Snoqualmie Police Department began delivering police services to the citizens of North Bend; and

**WHEREAS**, the Snoqualmie Police Department has historically contracted with the City of Issaquah for 911 dispatch services; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 25, 2014, the three cities of North Bend, Snoqualmie and Issaquah executed an Interlocal Agreement for 911 Police Dispatch and Records Management Services (“ILA”); and

**WHEREAS**, the ILA contains a section relating to startup costs; however, all startup costs have been paid in full; and

**WHEREAS**, the parties further wish to reduce the automatic price escalator in the ILA from 5% to 3%;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The First Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement Between the Cities of Issaquah, Snoqualmie, and North Bend for Police Dispatch and Records Management Services is approved and the Mayor is authorized to execute the Amendment in a form attached hereto as Exhibit A.
