

RESOLUTION 1904

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, ACCEPTING MILLION TREES GRANT FUNDS FROM KING COUNTY URBAN REFORESTATION AND HABITAT RESTORATION (“URHR”) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$30,000.00 FOR TREE PLANTING ALONG THE SOUTH FORK SNOQUALMIE RIVER AND UNNAMED TRIBUTARY IN MEADOWBROOK FARM

WHEREAS, the City of North Bend (“City”) applied for funding through the Watershed Resource Inventory Area (“WRIA 7”) via the Snoqualmie Watershed Forum recommendation; and

WHEREAS, the City will help reach King County’s Million Tree goals by providing general habitat restoration by planting trees in existing open space; and

WHEREAS, King County URHR awarded the City a grant in an amount of not exceeding \$30,000 for Riparian, Floodplain and Wetland Enhancement, the agreement for which is attached hereto as Exhibit A;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The King County URHR Grant in the amount not exceeding \$30,000 for North Bend Tree Planting in 2019 and 2020 is approved, and the Mayor is authorized to enter into the agreement with King County attached hereto as Exhibit A, in a final form and content acceptable to the City Attorney.
