

RESOLUTION 1909

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, ACCEPTING THE 412TH AVENUE SE AC WATERMAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT AS COMPLETE AND AUTHORIZING THE RELEASE OF RETAINAGE

WHEREAS, the 412th Avenue SE AC Watermain Replacement Project was a high priority watermain replacement project as there have been numerous breaks and service leaks along this stretch of line that feeds the I-90 Reservoir; and

WHEREAS, staff advertised for bids and received ten (10) bids, the lowest bid coming from D&G Backhoe, Inc. in the amount of \$415,907.40; and

WHEREAS, D&G Backhoe, Inc., began work on the project on June 10, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Project was declared Physically Complete on September 13th, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the final construction cost of the project was \$399,990.23 which was a savings of \$15,917.17 from the awarded amount of \$415,907.40; and

WHEREAS, the City must accept the project prior to submitting for releases from the State Department of Revenue, Department of Labor and Industries, and the Employment Security Department for the retainage of the contractor;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND,
WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The City of North Bend accepts D&G Backhoe, Inc., work on the 412th Avenue SE AC Watermain Replacement Project.

Section 2. The City of North Bend authorizes the release of the retainage on the contract upon receipt of the appropriate clearances from the state.
