

RESOLUTION 1912

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, ACCEPTING THE 710 AND 780 PUMP STATION REPAIRS PROJECT AS COMPLETE AND AUTHORIZING THE RELEASE OF RETAINAGE

WHEREAS, City of North Bend (“City”) staff solicited quotes for the 710 and 780 Pump Station Repairs Project (the Project) from Grundfos CBS, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, Grundfos CBS, Inc. is the legal sole-source provider for parts and service for PACO pumps in the region; and

WHEREAS, Grundfos CBS, Inc. submitted a quote in the amount of \$6,328.18, including tax; and

WHEREAS, the Project was administratively awarded to Grundfos CBS, Inc. on June 19, 2019; and

WHEREAS, Grundfos CBS, Inc. began work on the project on June 19, 2019; and

WHEREAS, wear on one of the pumps was more substantial than originally scoped; and

WHEREAS, Contract Amendment #1 was executed on August 13, 2019; and

WHEREAS, work on the project was completed on August 20, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the final cost of the project was \$7,458.41; and

WHEREAS, the City must accept projects prior to submitting for releases from the State Department of Revenue, Department of Labor and Industries, and the Employment Security Department for the retainage of the contractor;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND,
WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The City of North Bend accepts Grundfos CBS, Inc.’s work on the 710 and 780 Pump Station Repairs Project.

Section 2. The City of North Bend authorizes the release of the retainage on the contract upon receipt of the appropriate clearances from the state.
