

RESOLUTION 1919

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, ADOPTING WRITTEN PROCUREMENT PROCEDURES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CODE OF FEDERAL REGULATIONS

WHEREAS, the City is an active participant in federal grant applications and receives federal grant proceeds for transportation, law enforcement, water/sewer and storm drainage utilities, and other worthwhile public benefits; and

WHEREAS, when the City is a recipient of Federal funds, the City has obligations to certain rules, regulations, and codes; and

WHEREAS, the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) is the codification of the general and permanent rules published in the Federal Register by the departments and agencies of the Federal Government and one such rule, Title 2: Grants and Agreements §200.318 General procurement standards requires that a non-Federal entity (a local government) must use its own documented procurement procedures which reflect applicable State, local, and tribal laws and regulations, provided that the procurements conform to applicable Federal law and the standards outlined in §200.318; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to comply with federal requirements associated with the receipt of federal funds and to adopt a procurement policy that complies with federal requirements;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Procurement Policy, Adopted: The City of North Bend hereby adopts the procurement policy attached hereto as Exhibit A. The City Council delegates to the City Finance Director the authority to make minor administrative changes to such policy, provided such changes are consistent with federal requirements.
