

ORDINANCE 1714

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING THE CITY'S 2019- 2020 BUDGET AND SALARY SCHEDULE ORDINANCE NO. 1679; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted the City's 2019-2020 Budget pursuant to Ordinance No. 1679 on December 4, 2018 and revised the budget pursuant to Ordinance No. 1686, Ordinance No. 1692, Ordinance No. 1703, and Ordinance No. 1710; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted the Mid-Biennium Budget Modification to the City's 2019-2020 Budget and the 2020 Salary Schedule pursuant to Ordinance No. 1711 on December 3, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the City is prohibited from over expending its appropriated budget as set forth in Ordinance No. 1711; and

WHEREAS, the City Council now desires to amend the 2020 Salary Schedule to add the position and salary range for the Deputy City Attorney position;

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, DO HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The 2020 Salary Schedule is hereby amended as set forth in Exhibit "A".

Section 2. Severability. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstance, be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid for any reason, or should any portion of this ordinance be pre-empted by state or federal law or regulation, such decision or pre-emption shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance or its application to other persons or circumstances.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be published in the official newspaper of
