

RESOLUTION 1931

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE DEVELOPER EXTENSION AGREEMENT WITH JOHN DAY HOMES INC. FOR THE TANNER VIEW SHORT PLAT INFRASTRUCTURE

WHEREAS, John Day Homes Inc., has applied for engineering plan approval for the proposed Tanner View 2-Lot Short Plat project located at 45010 SE 136th Street; and

WHEREAS, the conditions of approval for finalizing the Tanner View 2-Lot Short Plat include the installation of infrastructure in accordance with City standards; and

WHEREAS, application was made with the City to construct extensions to the City's storm water and street systems for the proposed Tanner View 2-Lot Short Plat project; and

WHEREAS, the City has prepared a Developer Extension Agreement for the required improvements; and

WHEREAS, the applicant will be required to pay fees and deposits for plan review and construction inspections along with applicable storm charges; and

WHEREAS, the City will be requiring that all deposits, fees, permits, bonds, and insurance be in place prior to any infrastructure work; and

WHEREAS, the City's Transportation and Public Works Committee considered the Developer Extension Agreement at its April 28, 2020 meeting and recommended approval of the Developer Extension Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Developer Extension Agreement with John Day Homes Inc., for infrastructure work associated with the proposed Tanner View 2-Lot Short Plat project is approved, in the form substantially the same as attached hereto as Exhibit A and as acceptable to the City Attorney.
