

RESOLUTION 1942

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AND CITY STAFF TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS FOR PEDESTRIAN AND STORMWATER IMPROVEMENTS ALONG 2ND STREET BETWEEN BALLARAT AVENUE NORTH AND BENDIGO BOULEVARD NORTH

WHEREAS, King County administers the Federal Community Development Block Grant funds (“CDBG”); and

WHEREAS, the City has made preliminary application to King County for funding of certain pedestrian and stormwater improvements along 2nd Street from Ballarat Avenue North to Bendigo Boulevard North (“Project”); and

WHEREAS, in order to meet the grant application criteria, the City is willing to provide \$615,075 as matching funds for the Project; and

WHEREAS, these improvements are included within the City’s Transportation Improvements Plan (“TIP”);

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Authorizing City Staff to Submit CDBG Grant and Matching Funds. The City Council authorizes City Staff to submit a grant application requesting CDBG funds for a project totaling \$915,075 and authorizing the City to match funds up to \$615,075.

Section 2. Authorizing the Mayor to Sign the Grant Application. The City Council authorizes the Mayor to execute the final grant application and all necessary materials to submit the application.
