

RESOLUTION 1943

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, ACCEPTING BIDS AND AWARDING CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR TANNER TRAIL EXTENSION PROJECT TO FURY SITE WORKS, INC.

WHEREAS, the Tanner Trail Extension Project extends a paved trail from Cedar Falls Way to Maloney Grove Avenue along North Bend Way; and

WHEREAS, other work shall include grading, drainage swales, ADA ramp at Maloney Grove Avenue crossing, new striping for crosswalk, and placement of conduit for future lighting along the trail; and

WHEREAS, the project is funded by Si View Metropolitan Park District Proposition 1 funds; and

WHEREAS, after design was completed and the appropriate advertisement period had been met, the City held a bid opening on Wednesday June 10, 2020 at 2:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, the City received bids from fifteen (15) contractors with the lowest bid coming from Fury Site Works, Inc. in the amount of \$167,625.00, including all applicable taxes;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The construction bids for the Tanner Trail Extension Project are accepted.

Section 2. The construction contract for the Tanner Trail Extension Project, is awarded to Fury Site Works, Inc., in the amount of \$167,625.00, including all applicable taxes, on a form to be approved by the City Attorney.
