

RESOLUTION 1958

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, ACCEPTING THE TANNER TRAIL EXTENSION CAPITAL PROJECT AS COMPLETE AND AUTHORIZING THE RELEASE OF RETAINAGE

WHEREAS, City of North Bend (“City”) staff advertised for bids for the Tanner Trail Extension Project (the Project); and

WHEREAS, Fury Site Works, Inc. submitted the lowest responsive and responsible bid; and

WHEREAS, the Project was awarded to Fury Site Works, Inc. on July 21, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Fury Site Works, Inc. began work in August 2020; and

WHEREAS, work on the project was completed on October 9, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the final cost of the project was \$200,079.80 including Change Order No. 1 and sales tax; and

WHEREAS, the City must accept projects prior to submitting for releases from the State Department of Revenue, Department of Labor and Industries, and the Employment Security Department for the retainage of the contractors;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City of North Bend accepts Fury Site Works, Inc. work on the Tanner Trail Extension Project.

Section 2. The City of North Bend authorizes the release of the retainage on the contract

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upon receipt of the appropriate clearances from the state.
