

# RESOLUTION 1961

## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON ACCEPTING A PUGET SOUND REGIONAL COUNCIL GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,380,610 FOR THE MT SI BLVD / SR 202 ROUNDABOUT CAPITAL TRANSPORTATION PROJECT

**WHEREAS**, the City of North Bend (“City”) annually designs and constructs transportation capital projects on City streets; and

**WHEREAS**, the City applied to Puget Sound Regional Council (PSRC) for grant funding through the Small City Program for \$1,380,610 in Federal Highway Administration funds; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mt. Si Blvd./ SR 202 Roundabout project is rated as one of the City’s highest priority transportation capital projects in the City’s 2020-2025 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP); and

**WHEREAS**, the PSRC awarded the City a grant in the amount of \$1,380,610 for the Mt. Si Blvd. / SR 202 Roundabout Project; and

**WHEREAS**, the PSRC awarded grant requires a match of \$233,600 which will be provided by the City or other outside sources;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The PSRC grant of \$1,380,610 for the Mt. Si Blvd / SR 202 Roundabout Project is accepted with a match requirement of \$233,600 that shall be provided by the City, and the Mayor is authorized to enter into any agreements with PSRC, in a form and content acceptable to the City Attorney.
