The Commission reviewed areas of focus based on the dot and mapping exercise. Strategies that received the most interest from Commissioners heavily focused on the goals of Healthy, Thriving Businesses and Tourism, Recreation, Arts + Culture. There was less focus on the goals of housing and fiscal sustainability, but that may reflect a lack of strategies in previous plans/documents focused on those goals.
