

RESOLUTION 2041

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, ACCEPTING THE RIBARY CREEK SEDIMENT POND MAINTENANCE PROJECT AS COMPLETE AND AUTHORIZING THE RELEASE OF RETAINAGE

WHEREAS, City of North Bend (City) staff requested bids for the Ribary Creek Sediment Pond Maintenance Project (Project); and

WHEREAS, Fury Site Works, Inc. submitted the lowest responsive and responsible bid; and

WHEREAS, the Project was awarded to Fury Site Works, Inc. on September 20, 2022; and

WHEREAS, Fury Site Works, Inc. completed work on September 28, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the final cost of the project was \$29,391.40 plus sales tax; and

WHEREAS, the City must accept projects prior to submitting for releases from the State Department of Revenue, Department of Labor and Industries, and the Employment Security Department for the retainage of the contractors;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City of North Bend accepts Fury Site Works, Inc. work on the Ribary Creek Sediment Pond Maintenance Project.

Section 2. The City of North Bend authorizes the release of the retainage on the contract upon receipt of the appropriate clearances from the state.
