

RESOLUTION 2052

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, ADOPTING THE CITY'S 2022 COMPREHENSIVE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PLAN (CEMP)

WHEREAS, the State of Washington requires each City to have an updated CEMP in order to be eligible for emergency related grants or reimbursement for disasters; and

WHEREAS, the City is required to update its CEMP once every 6 years; and

WHEREAS, the City last updated its CEMP in 2015 which was scheduled to expire at the end of 2021; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the COVID 19 State of Emergency declared by Governor Inslee and the State of Washington, the State of Washington granted an extension of one year to complete the CEMP; and

WHEREAS, the City's 2015 CEMP, including the one-year extension, expired at the end of 2022; and

WHEREAS, the City adopts the 2022 CEMP herein to comply with the State of Washington's CEMP amendment requirement;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The 2022 City of North Bend Comprehensive Management Plan, attached hereto as Exhibit A and by this reference incorporated herein, is hereby adopted.
