



City of North Bend Sewer Billing:

Your sewer bill is billed based on your water usage; the more water that is used will affect your sewer bill.

In the winter months we bill sewer on actual water usage. The base fee for 2022 is \$83.01 and includes the first 10 cubic meters of usage. If your water usage is above 10CM, each cubic meter is \$8.28. For 5 months of the year, we bill the actual usage. For the other 7 months we bill on a winter average, so people are not penalized for outside water use and other summertime activities.

Winter average is based on the November-March usage. If you use less water than the average, we bill you the actual amount. If usage is less than 10CM, you will be billed the base fee.

2022 base rate for sewer is \$83.01 and each cubic meter of usage above 10CM is \$8.28.
