OF THE CITY OF DUVALL***

WHEREAS, in March 1909 the City of North Bend was incorporated; and

WHEREAS, North Bend is located in the foothills of the Cascade Range in the upper valley of the Snoqualmie River and is surrounded by the beautiful Mount Si and Rattlesnake Ridge; and

WHEREAS, the town was originally named Mountain View, and was renamed North Bend after its location near the north bend of the South Fork of the Snoqualmie River; and

WHEREAS, North Bend was made famous by David Lynch's television series Twin Peaks; and

WHEREAS, after 100 years, the City of North Bend continues to be culturally diverse, economically vibrant, and deeply connected to the neighboring cities throughout the Snoqualmie Valley; and

WHEREAS, Duvall values the long relationship of all of the Snoqualmie Valley cities and it is through this relationship that we have provided many amenities for all of our Valley residents.
